Day 1 - Tues 13 June - Depart Dublin

Day 2 - Weds 14 June - In Transit

Day 3 - Thurs 15 June -- Arrive Auckland. On arrival you are transferred to 4* Crowne Plaza Hotel for two nights. From the iconic Sky Tower to the trendy Waterfront, the "City of Sails" is a vibrant city. Click here for a great overview of Auckland.

Day 4 - Fri 16 June - Auckland. Day at leisure. This evening we have arranged a Tour Dinner including a few drinks!

Day 5 - Sat 17 June - Rotorua - Match Day! The British & Irish Lions v Maori All Blacks. This morning we depart for Rotorua for the unofficial "Fourth Test"! The huge local Maori population will ensure a cracking atmosphere. Post match we transfer (less than one hour) to the 4* Waireke Resort, Taupo famed for its geothermal grounds. Check in for four relaxing nights.

Day 6 - Sun 18 June - Taupo. Day at leisure. Snow capped mountains, crystal clear waters, raging rapids, thermal hot springs and lush greenery are just some of the incredible natural attributes on offer in Taupo. A day trip to Rotorua is included and we will soon have some optional activities for you to book should you so wish.

Day 7 - Mon 19 June - Taupo. Day at leisure with a Tour Dinner tonight including some drinks!

TOUR ADD ONS



We are extremely flexible so if you are looking to extend your stay in NZ, visit Australia or chill out in Fiji then let us know. We would be delighted to quote for any additional requests that you may have. **TIME DIFFERENCE:** During May, June and July New Zealand is +12 hours ahead of GMT.

CLIMATE: The average NZ temperature decreases as you travel south. July is the coldest month of the year with daytime temperatures between 10-15°C.

FLYING TIMES: The total flying and transfer time from Dublin to Auckland is 30 hours approx.

LOCAL CURRENCY: New Zealand's unit of currency is the dollar (NZ\$). All major credit cards can be used in New Zealand, with Visa and MasterCard accepted most widely.

HEALTH: No inoculations are required. We strongly advise you to arrange your own health insurance. New Zealand's public and private medical/hospital facilities provide a high standard of treatment and service, but it is important to note these services are not free to visitors, except as a result of an accident.

SECURITY: Visitors are advised to take the same care with your personal safety and your possessions as you would do at home. Take copies of your important documents (like your passport and credit cards) and keep them separate from the originals. You should also keep a record of the description and serial number of valuable items (like cameras, tablets and smart phones). And remember, in an emergency dial 111.

ACCOMMODATION: All accommodation is mainly 4 star on a bed and breakfast basis. Some 4* motels may be included and all are of a high standard.

FLIGHTS: International Flights are operated by Emirates but we reserve the right to change carrier.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One suitcase check in (up to 23kg) and two pieces of hand luggage per person (1 handbag/laptop bag & 1 additional cabin bag). Upgraded seats have a greater allowance.









FLIGHT UPGRADES: Although the comfort and service offered by the airlines we use is excellent, you may wish to upgrade your flight to Business Class (not available for internal flights). Please ask for details as prices do fluctuate.

HOTELS: Prices are based on twin/double rooms with two people sharing. If a triple room is requested, this is likely to be a double bed plus a sofa bed and is subject to availability. Single occupancy incurs a single room supplement as outlined in our costs. Should we (through circumstances beyond our control) be forced to change your accommodation, we will advise you at the earliest opportunity. In these rare cases we will offer a hotel of the same standard or higher and any extra cost will be absorbed by us.

CHANGES TO YOUR HOLIDAY: It is unlikely that we will have to make changes to your travel arrangements but we do plan many years and months in advance and therefore occasionally we may have to make changes and we reserve the right to do so at any time.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Travel documents will be issued to you 14 days approx prior to departure.

PASSPORTS: All passengers travelling require a full passport. In the case of people coming to New Zealand temporarily, the passport must be valid either:

- For at least 3 months beyond the date you intend to depart NZ, or
- For one month beyond the date you intend to depart NZ, if the issuing government has consular representation in New Zealand that is able to issue and renew travel documents (you should check with your issuing authority before travelling).

VISAS: Visas are NOT required for travel to New Zealand from Ireland, UK and the EU.





TOUR MERCHANDISE: Official merchandise will be provided and details will be announced shortly.

CANCELLATION CHARGES: Should you wish to cancel your booking, we will require notification in writing. Cancellation charges will be levied in accordance with the scale set out in our <u>full</u> set of terms and conditions.

MATCH CANCELLATION: RTI cannot be responsible for refunds of money due to cancellation of matches as a result of inclement weather, outbreak of disease, terrorism or events beyond our control.

INSURANCE: It is a condition of our tours that the Consumer is covered either by the travel insurance scheme arranged by the Organiser, or covered by another travel insurance scheme which furnishes the Consumer with at least the same level of cover as that afforded by the travel scheme arranged by the Organiser. In the event that the Consumer does not avail of the Organiser's travel insurance scheme, he must furnish details of the alternative travel insurance scheme which he has arranged at the time of booking. It is the responsibility of the Consumer to check that the insurance scheme provides the Consumer with his desired level of cover. In so arranging insurance cover for the Consumer the Organiser is acting as the agent of the relevant insurer and shall not be responsible to the Consumer for any default by the insurer under that policy. All claims made against the insurance policy shall be made directly to the insurer. The Consumer shall be responsible for making any special or increased insurance arrangements which he deems necessary
