CAPE TOWN - MONDAY 9TH APRIL

Group Dinner at Quay Four Restaurant

Price p/p: €50

This evening there will be an opportunity to dine in Cape Town's legendary Quay Four Restaurant with your fellow tourists. Quay Four is one of the oldest restaurants on the V&A Waterfront and now a famous landmark. The terrace of the world-renowned downstairs tavern buzzes with locals and visitors alike, virtually every day of the year. This package includes a sumptuous three course dinner with two complimentary glasses of wine or two beers or two soft drinks included.

All other drinks to be paid individually on the night.

CAPE TOWN - TUESDAY 10TH APRIL

Robben Island Tour

Price p/p: €45

(Departing hotel at approx 10.15 & returning by approx 15.00)

The historic political prison for former South African President Nelson Mandela and the current President Jacob Zuma, is visited every year by thousands of people eager to understand and honour the important aspects of South Africa's history that the Island represents.

This tour includes return bus transfers from the hotel to the Waterfront, return ferry crossing and a tour of Robben Island. Whilst on the island you will be guided through the graveyard of people who died from leprosy, the Lime Quarry, Robert Sobukwe's house, the Bluestone quarry, the army and navy bunkers and the Maximum Security Prison where thousands of South Africa's freedom fighters were incarcerated for years. The tour culminates with a viewing of Nelson Mandela's cell. On your return, relax at the Waterfront. If you wish to book the Table Mountain trip as well, the coach will depart from the Waterfront.

Table Mountain

Price p/p: €40

(Coach departing from Waterfront at approx 15.45, collection from hotel at 15.55 returning to hotel for approx 19.00)

The awe inspiring Table Mountain is a must see for any visit to Cape Town. Table Mountain is a flat-topped mountain forming a prominent landmark overlooking the city of Cape Town in South Africa. It is a significant tourist attraction, and is a great spot to sit and soak up the commanding 360-degree views of Cape Town, Table Bay, the nearby peaks of the surrounding mountains and the rest of the Table Mountain National Park, in which the Cableway is situated. This tour includes return coach transfers from the V&A Waterfront/hotel and cable car up and down to Table Mountain.

Please note that both tours today are weather dependent. If they are cancelled due to inclement weather you will get a full refund. You can choose to book either tour or both these tours on this day.

CAPE TOWN - WEDNESDAY 11TH APRIL

Full Day Winelands Tour Price p/p: €70

The famous South African wine region of Stellenbosch & Franschhoek are the destinations of the day on Wednesday 11th April as we head for a luxurious full day of wine tasting. We will visit three wine estates sampling a number of wines at each venue whilst also having lunch included at one of the estates.

Helicopter Trips of Cape Town
