Saturday 26 July

Match Day - **Second Test!** Wallabies v The Lions, MCG. *Please note there are no match transfers included because the public transport infrastructure is far quicker!*

Sunday 27 July

Check out of your hotel and fly to Ayers Rock (3hr5m). On arrival, transfer to the 3* Desert Garden Hotel and check in for 2 nights B&B. This afternoon, you will be taken to the base of the Kata Tjuta and walk through Walpa Gorge. Then travel into the National Park and take your place at the Uluru Sunset Platform. Watch as the sun sets over the outback and changes the colours of Uluru. This is followed by an Uluru BBQ Dining Experience: Wonder at the scale of Uluru at night on the only evening dining experience inside Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park. Explore native apple, bush tomato, and quandong flavours, savour renowned Australian BBQ steak, kangaroo and seafood, fresh salads and classic dessert with a twist. All accompanied by Australian wine and star gazing with our local guide.

Monday 28 July

Uluru Sunrise Tour: Departing the resort early this morning (collect your boxed breakfast from hotel reception), travel through the landscapes to the entrance of the Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park. As you travel towards Uluru, its vast shape rises from the sand dunes in the early dawn light, highlighting its presence in this country. Your guide will take you to a special location to watch the sun rise over this amazing monolith and enjoy breakfast. You will visit Mutijulu Waterhole on the Kuniya Walk and learn the Creation stories of Liru (poisonous snake) and Kuniya (python). After this short walk we will drive around the base of Uluru and hear the story of the Mala people before returning to the resort. Afternoon at leisure - you may want to join any complimentary activities the resort has to offer.

Tuesday 29 July

Depart Ayers Rock for Kings Canyon, enroute we will stop at Curtin Springs for a two-course lunch (included, ex-drinks) and view Atila (Mt. Conner). After turning off the Lasseter Highway and onto Luritja Road your Driver Guide will provide commentary about the history of the surrounding cattle stations. Check into the <u>3* Kings Canyon Resort</u> for 1 nights DB&B. Enjoy a 3 course dinner (included, ex-drinks) at the hotel this evening.

GUARANTEED

PASSPORTS: All passengers travelling require a full passport. In the case of people coming to Australia temporarily, the passport must be valid either for at least 6 months beyond the date you intend to travel to and from Australia.

All passengers other than Australian and New Zealand citizens need to present the following documents to officers in immigration clearance:

- a valid passport
- a valid visa to enter Australia (including electronic visas). Residents of Republic of Ireland, United Kingdom and Europe need a travel visa to enter Australia and stay for a duration of up to 90 days. You can get further information and apply online free of charge for the eVisitor (subclass 651) visa by <u>clicking here</u> www.immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas
- a completed and signed Incoming Passenger card, including health and character declaration.

Anyone who arrives without a valid travel document, visa or authority, might be refused entry to Australia or delayed until their identity and claims to enter Australia have been confirmed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

TIME DIFFERENCE: During May, June and July Australia is +8 or 12 hours ahead of GMT.

CLIMATE: The average daytime temperatures on tour range from 18° in Perth and Sydney, 21° in Brisbane, 26° in Cairns. Melbourne averages are around 14° and rain is most likely here.

FLYING TIMES: The total flying and transfer time from Dublin to Australia is 30 hours approx.

LOCAL CURRENCY: The Australian dollar is the currency used in Australia. The exchange rate as od is €1 = \$1.65 & £1 = \$1.94. Rate correct as of March 2024

HEALTH: No inoculations are required. We strongly advise you to arrange your own health insurance. Australia's public and private medical/hospital facilities provide a high standard of treatment and service, but it is important to note these services are not free to visitors, except as a result of an accident.

SECURITY: Visitors are advised to take the same care with your personal safety and your possessions as you would do at home. Take copies of your important documents (like your passport and credit cards) and keep them separate from the originals. You should also keep a record of the description and serial number of valuable items (like cameras, tablets and smart phones). And remember, in an emergency dial 000.

ACCOMMODATION: All accommodation is 4 & 5 star hotels on a bed and breakfast basis.

FLIGHTS: We only ever work with highly reputable International airlines.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One check in item (minimum 20kg check in allowance) and two pieces of hand luggage per person (1 handbag/laptop bag & 1 additional cabin bag).

TOUR MERCHANDISE: Official merchandise will be provided.

CANCELLATION CHARGES: Should you wish to cancel your booking, we will require notification in writing. Cancellation charges will be levied in accordance with the scale set out in our full set of terms and conditions.

INSURANCE: We consider adequate travel insurance with a reputable insurance company to be essential and as such we make it a condition of our contract with you. Your travel insurance should cover the cost of cancellation, medical expenses, loss of luggage or money, personal liability claims, participation in activities and costs of assistance (including repatriation) in the event of accident, injury, illness (including full Covid-19 cover) or death.

FLIGHT UPGRADES: Although the comfort and service offered by the airlines we use is excellent, you may wish to upgrade your flight to Business Class or First Class (not available for internal flights). Please ask for details as prices do fluctuate.

INTERESTED IN ROOM SHARING: All our rates and charges are calculated on the basis of two people sharing a room. If a room is being used by just one person, then the single supplement makes up for the unsold "half" of the room. If you are travelling solo and wish to share with someone to avoid the single supplement, then we are happy to help pair you with another similar tour guest with the same request. We will put you directly in touch with each other and you can both make the decision whether you are suitable to share throughout the tour. If a suitable person cannot be found, the single room supplement will be payable in full no later than 31 March 2025.

HOTELS: Tour costs are based on twin/double rooms with two people sharing. Triple/Family rooms can be quoted subject to availability. Should we change your hotel we will advise you at the earliest opportunity, but we will always endeavour to offer a hotel of the same standard. If this is not possible, an alternative will be provided, and a credit note will be applied. All accommodation is on a bed and breakfast basis.

CHANGES TO YOUR TOUR: RTI reserve the right to change/readjust the tour schedule, transportation, hotel accommodation and services indicated in the package. Promotions may end without notice. All tours are subject to availability. It is unlikely that we will have to make changes to your travel arrangements but we reserve the right to do so at any time.

IF YOU WISH TO CANCEL: If you cancel prior to 30 Jun 2024 = 25% deposit cancellation charge. If you cancel between 01 Aug – 31 Oct = 50% cancellation charge. If you cancel between 01 Nov – 31 Jan = 70% cancellation charge. If you cancel between 01 Feb 2025 – 28 Feb 2025 = 90% cancellation charge. If you cancel on or after 01 Mar 2025 = 100% cancellation charge.
