ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Travel documents will be issued to you 14 - 30 days approx prior to departure via the RTI Travel App.

PASSPORTS: All passengers travelling require a full passport. In the case of people coming to Australia temporarily, the passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date you intend to travel to and from Australia.

All passengers other than Australian and New Zealand citizens need to present the following documents to officers in immigration clearance:

- a valid passport
- a valid visa to enter Australia (including electronic visas). Residents of Republic of Ireland, United Kingdom and Europe need a travel visa to enter Australia and stay for a duration of up to 90 days. You can get further information and apply online free of charge for the eVisitor (subclass 651) visa by clicking here www.immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas
- a completed and signed Incoming Passenger card, including health and character declaration.

Anyone who arrives without a valid travel document, visa or authority, might be refused entry to Australia or delayed until their identity and claims to enter Australia have been confirmed.



TIME DIFFERENCE: During May, June and July Australia is +8 to 12 hours ahead of GMT.

CLIMATE: The average daytime temperatures on tour will range from 18° in Perth and Sydney, 21° in Brisbane, 26° in Cairns. Melbourne averages are around 14° and rain is most likely here.

FLYING TIMES: The total flying and transfer time from Dublin to Australia is 30 hours approx.

LOCAL CURRENCY: The Australian dollar is the currency used in Australia. The exchange rate as od is $\le 1 = \$1.65 \& £1 = \1.94 . Rate correct as of March 2024.

HEALTH: No inoculations are required. We strongly advise you to arrange your own health insurance. Australia's public and private medical/hospital facilities provide a high standard of treatment and service, but it is important to note these services are not free to visitors, except as a result of an accident.

SECURITY: Visitors are advised to take the same care with your personal safety and your possessions as you would do at home. Take copies of your important documents (like your passport and credit cards) and keep them separate from the originals. You should also keep a record of the description and serial number of valuable items (like cameras, tablets and smart phones). And remember, in an emergency dial 000.

ACCOMMODATION: All accommodation is 4 & 5 star hotels on a bed and breakfast basis.

FLIGHTS: We only ever work with highly reputable International Airlines.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One check in item (minimum 20kg check in allowance) and two pieces of hand luggage per person (1 handbag/laptop bag & 1 additional cabin bag).

TOUR MERCHANDISE: Official merchandise will be provided.

CANCELLATION CHARGES: Should you wish to cancel your booking, we will require notification in writing. Cancellation charges will be levied in accordance with the scale set out in our full set of terms and conditions.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

INSURANCE: We consider adequate travel insurance with a reputable insurance company to be essential and as such we make it a condition of our contract with you. Your travel insurance should cover the cost of cancellation, medical expenses, loss of luggage or money, personal liability claims, participation in activities and costs of assistance (including repatriation) in the event of accident, injury, illness (including full Covid-19 cover) or death.

FLIGHT UPGRADES: Although the comfort and service offered by the airlines we use is excellent, you may wish to upgrade your flight to Business Class or First Class (not available for domestic flights). Please ask for details as prices do fluctuate.

INTERESTED IN ROOM SHARING: All our rates and charges are calculated on the basis of two people sharing a room. If a room is being used by just one person, then the single supplement makes up for the unsold "half" of the room. If you are travelling solo and wish to share with someone to avoid the single supplement, then we are happy to help pair you with another similar tour guest with the same request. We will put you directly in touch with each other and you can both make the decision whether you are suitable to share throughout the tour. If a suitable person cannot be found, then the single room supplement will be payable in full no later than 31 March 2025.

FINANCIAL PROTECTION - BOOK WITH CONFIDENCE: OTP Travel Services Ltd T/A Rugby Travel Ireland (RTI) is fully bonded assuring you that your monies are secure at all times. Rugby Travel Ireland is bonded and licensed with the Irish Aviation Authority Regulation, Tour Operators Licence No. T.O.260. Further details are available at www.iaa.ie/.

HOTELS: Tour costs are based on twin/double rooms with two people sharing. Triple/Family rooms can be quoted subject to availability. Should we change your hotel we will advise you at the earliest opportunity, but we will always endeavour to offer a hotel of the same standard. If this is not possible, an alternative will be provided, and a credit note will be applied. All accommodation is on a bed and breakfast basis.

CHANGES TO YOUR TOUR: RTI reserve the right to change/readjust the tour schedule, transportation, hotel accommodation and services indicated in the package. Promotions may end without notice. All tours are subject to availability. It is unlikely that we will have to make changes to your travel arrangements but we reserve the right to do so at any time.

IF YOU WISH TO CANCEL: If you cancel prior to 30 Jun 2024 = 25% deposit cancellation charge. If you cancel between 01 Aug -31 Oct = 50% cancellation charge. If you cancel between 01 Nov -31 Jan = 70% cancellation charge. If you cancel between 01 Feb 2025 - 28 Feb 2025 = 90% cancellation charge. If you cancel on or after 01 Mar 2025 = 100% cancellation charge.

If the reason for your cancellation is covered under the terms of your insurance policy, you may be able to reclaim these charges from your insurer. This is why it is imperative that you have travel insurance in place well in advance of you travelling.
