#### Wednesday 26th March

Depart Dublin to LHR to connect onto your flight with Cathay Pacific direct to Hong Kong.

#### Thursday 27th March

Land at 14:35 local time and transfer to the <u>5\* InterContinental Hotel.</u> Check in for 4 nights B&B. This evening, enjoy an amazing Sunset Dinner & Cruise package. Witness Hong Kong's breathtaking harbour view during sundown while dining at an award-winning Chinese restaurant. Then board an iconic red-sail junk boat for a 45 minute cruise with the best seats in town for the spectacular lights, laser and music show that lights up the harbour and the city's skyscrapers.

#### Friday 28th March

Enjoy today at leisure. You have plenty of time to explore Hong Kong because the opening matches do not begin until the afternoon and usually feature teams from lower-ranked rugby nations. The hotel runs a complimentary shuttle to and from the Kai Tak Sports Ground (10 mins) and is on a first come first serve basis. In the evening enjoy the more high-profile matches involving top-tier teams. Enjoy the electrifying vibe as the stadium fills up! You can then head out after the last match to explore the nightlife in areas like Lan Kwai Fong or Wan Chai.

#### Saturday 29th March

This morning the matches continue, with teams trying to advance out of the group stages. The afternoon has more intense matches as some of the bigger rugby nations compete in the knockout stages. This evening is typically the most lively time with fans in full fancy-dress costume! Explore some of Hong Kong's nightlife post-games, such as Victoria Peak for evening views or bar hopping.

#### Sunday 30th March

It's Finals Day! The morning kicks off with more knockout-stage matches as the competition narrows down. This is a great time to catch up on local Hong Kong food nearby for a brunch before entering the stadium. In the afternoon the semi-finals and finals are held to determine the winners. The atmosphere is electric, and the crowd energy peaks with every big play. After the final match, there is huge fireworks display and prize ceremony. You can celebrate with fans and enjoy the city's nightlight one last time.







#### Monday 31st March

Check out of the InterContinental Hotel and transfer to Hong Kong Airport for your flight to Singapore. Land and transfer to the centrally located <u>5\* Naumi Hotel</u> for two nights. Evening at leisure.

#### **Tuesday 1st April**

Singapore Full Day City Tour with English speaking guide. Head to Merlion Park and enjoy views of Singapore's iconic Merlion statue, with fantastic photo opportunities against Marina Bay Sands and the waterfront skyline. Walking along the river front proceed to National Gallery for a tour of the historical building with a stunning view of the Padang. Next up is a chance to explore the vibrant Chinatown where you have lunch (at own expense) and enjoy Singapore's Street Food. We then visit the Gardens by the Bay that comprises two cooled conservatories - Cloud Forest and Flower Dome. You also visit Super Tree Grove and Dragon Fly Lake followed by a walk over to Marina Bay Sands for a peek into this luxurious hotel! We then transfer to Raffles Hotel for an obligatory Singapore Sling (at own expense). It is now around 4.30pm and time to return to the hotel to freshen up for the evening. Depart at 6pm for dinner (included set menu) where you will enjoy a delicious Peranakan dinner, sampling a selection of local dishes. Conclude the day with the spectacular light and music show at Marina Bay Reservoir and then transfer back to the hotel around 8.30pm.

#### Wednesday 2nd April

Check out of the hotel and enjoy a visit to the beautiful National Orchid Gardens which has the worlds largest collection of orchids. Then transfer to the airport for your flight to Hanoi, Vietnam. Then transfer the  $5^*$  The Legend Hanoi Hotel for two nights. Evening at leisure.

#### **Thursday 3rd April**

Today enjoy a full city tour of Hanoi with our English speaking tour guide. The tour will take you through the famous city with the first stop at the Temple of Literature. This was Vietnams first national university and dates back to 1070. Following this, visit Dong Xuan market, which is the Old Quarters largest market, home to exotic plants fruits and fragrant flowers. Then continue to the Hoa Lo Prison which holds lots of history of the American war. In the afternoon, visit Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum (outside visit) and his personal residence, the One Pillar Pagoda. There is then the option of a leisurely ride on a cyclo around Hoan Kiem Lake, before enjoying a water puppet show in the early evening. If time permits, pay a visit to a local coffee shop and enjoy Hanoi's specialty - Egg Coffee. Dinner (set menu) is at the Ly Club local restaurant and is part of your tour price (includes a mineral water/coffee/tea or soft drink).







#### Friday 4th April

After an early breakfast, you will travel to the stunning and picturesque Ha Long Bay (around 2.5 hour drive) located in the Gulf of Tonkin. You will be taken aboard our support vessel and travel from Tuan Chau Marina via the bay to board the luxurious craft, the <u>5\* Mon Chéri Cruise</u>. Welcome fresh drinks, wet towels and a special lunch of fresh food and an assortment of appetizing delicacies will be served. You will be enchanted when decadently dining on the luxury junk. Life just doesn't get better than this! We then set sail for Lan Ha Bay - A member of the World's Most Beautiful Bays. Enjoy the delicious luncheon and an assortment of appetizing delicacies while cruising along Lan Ha Bay with the breathtaking scenery. Visiting Tra Bau area which is known as an area famous for its unspoiled, poetic natural beauty and attractive seascape of Lan Ha Bay. This is the best time for kayaking (included) to discover the truest beauty of the limestone islands. Immerse yourself in the emerald green water of the bay or enjoy the Jacuzzi pool on the Mon Chéri. Later, enjoy a cooking demonstration to learn how to make one of the most famous Vietnamese cuisines, the spring rolls. Visit the top deck of the cruise where you can admire the magnificent sunset over the Gulf of Tonkin. Relax on the top deck just under the cover of a brightly illuminated sky or try to get your luck at the squid fishing on the main deck. Overnight is on board!

#### Saturday 5th April

If you wish, begin the day full of energy with a Tai Chi session and enjoy the sun just rising up beyond the horizon. Breakfast is served while cruising back to Gia Luan jetty. You will join the tour of Cat Ba World Biosphere by transshipment. It takes 30 minutes to transfer from Gia Luan to Trung Trang – one of the most impressive caves in Cat Ba Island, Vietnam. The limestone cave has thousands of stalactites in various shapes, offering geological values with a typical cave ecosystem. Return to the main boat from the cave and then check out (please place luggage outside of the cabin). Disembark and transfer back to Hanoi. On the way, stop to visit the village of Yen Duc in Dong Trieu District which is situated on the way between Hanoi and Ha Long. Recognized in 1993 as a national relic, Yen Duc is typical of a countryside Vietnamese village still engaged in rice cultivation and farming activities. The village's historical ties date back to the Ly and Tran dynasty (10-14th century) and in modern history was considered a cradle of the revolutionary movements during the French Indochina War. Enjoy a tour around the village beginning with the charming fields, and the amazing tranquility in Yen Duc village, stop to visit the Canh Huong pagoda was built in the Tran Dynasty and associated with Buddha Emperor Tran Nhan Tong and Truc Lam Yen Tu Buddhism. Meet and talk with the friendly villagers to get an understanding of local life and family tradition and join the rice-pounding experience with them.

Then you depart and return to Hanoi. Check back into the <u>5\* The Legend Hanoi Hotel</u> for one night. End of tour dinner (included) tonight.





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#### Sunday 6th April

Transfer to Hanoi airport for you flight to Hong Kong. Land in Hong Kong. Your flight back home is not until so we have organised a lovely excursion on arrival at Hong Kong! Private transfer (30 mins) to a lovely beachside restaurant on Cheung Sha Beach with stunning views next to Hong Kong's longest white sand swimming beach. Instant holiday vibes guaranteed, edged between the peaks of Lantau and the ocean of the South China Sea. A late lunch (set menu) is included (ex drinks). Transfer back to the airport and check in for your flight. Flight departs for LHR.

#### Monday 7th April

Land in LHR at 06:20 and connect onto your 08:25 flight for Dublin. What a great tour and thank you for travelling with Rugby Travel Ireland.

# **VISA / PASSPORT INFORMATION**

When travelling to Singapore, a visa is NOT required for Irish or UK passport holders but your passport must be valid for at least six months beyond your date of departure.

When travelling to Vietnam, Irish passport holders are required to hold a visa and the eVisa must be applied for through Vietnam Immigration's eVisa portal <u>https://evisa.xuatnhapcanh.gov.vn/en\_US/web/guest/khai-thi-thuc-dien-tu/cap-thi-thuc-dien-tu</u> (please note that this is the only official eVisa portal for Vietnam). Current cost is €23pp.

UK passport holders do NOT require a visa for trips up to 15 days in Vietnam.
