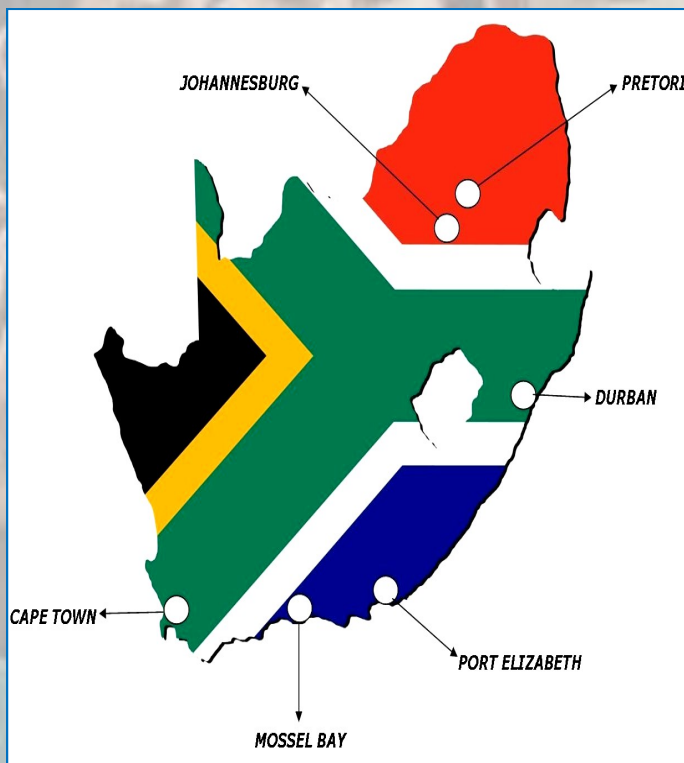

DAYS 1-7

Day

TOUR TIME!

1

The moment has finally arrived - you depart for Cape Town today for your tour of a lifetime!

CAPE TOWN

Check into your hotel for a three night stay. Blow off the cobwebs and be blown away with a ferry trip to Robben Island where Nelson Mandela spent 18 of his 27 years in prison. Your trip includes a return boat trip across Table Bay, a visit to the maximum security prison and interaction with an ex political prisoner.

CAPE TOWN

3

MATCH DAY! This morning head for Table Mountain. Take the cableway over 300m above sea level and enjoy lunch at the summit with superb views of Cape Town, Table Bay, Robben Island and the Atlantic seaboard. Back to sea level for your match against local opposition this afternoon followed by a post match social event with your opponents.

CAPE TOWN

4

This morning is a guided tour of a local Township - a thought provoking insight into the social fabric of Cape Town. You will visit a school, orphanage, community centre and a traditional healer. Tonight we recommend a tour dinner to one of the great restaurants on the world famous V&A Waterfront.

Day

MOSSEL BAY

5

Depart Cape Town by coach on the famous Garden Route to Mossel Bay, situated half way between Cape Town and Port Elizabeth. Located by the warm Indian Ocean it has a mild climate all year. Check into your hotel for a one night stay. Enjoy a pre dinner game of touch on one of the sandy beaches followed by a refreshing dip.

PORT ELIZABETH

6

Depart today for Port Elizabeth (PE) continuing along the Garden Route as it hugs the Indian Ocean. Stop for lunch at the worlds highest bridge bungee jump, Bloukrans Bridge. If you're brave enough why not have a go! Arrive in PE and check in for your two night stay. PE is known as the "Friendly City" with long sandy beaches and plenty of water sports.

MATCH DAY! First off is a visit to the Kwantu Game Reserve. Enjoy an exhilarating three hour game reserve drive where you are guaranteed to see Africa's Big Five (Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Buffalo and Rhino) followed by lunch.
