



Tamborine Mountain 4WD Tour - Half Day

Discover the secrets of this magnificent Mountain Rainforest. Learn about Bush Tucker and local flora and fauna on a guided Bushwalk. Sample wines at a local Winery & Vineyard. Discover waterfalls cascading into mountain streams, thick green rainforests alive with native birds and animals and the rugged hillside trails on Tamborine Mountain. Sighting of kangaroos in the Tamborine area is common and not to forget the koala who are often seen sleeping the day away in a gum tree beside one of the rough bush tracks. Morning tea with scones is also included.

Joalah National park will be your first stop where your experienced guides will guide you through and explain the uniqueness of the Rainforests and Eucalyptus forests that make up the Tamborine Plateau. The carefully worked out timetable allows for frequent stops to take in the sweeping views plus leisurely walks through the forests. In addition to this you will see a whip cracking display and then get the chance to try it yourself. Don't think your going to get out of the Boomerang throwing! They will also give you lesson on how to throw and define the difference between a boomerang and a stick!! The return journey to the Gold Coast provides sweeping views of Coast and surrounding mountain ranges.




Australian Zoo Tour - Full day



Undoubtedly a highlight of any visit to Southern Queensland is a trip to Australia Zoo. This tour goes directly to and from Australia Zoo, made famous by the antics of Steve and Terri Irwin and their global documentaries; the zoo is now a living legacy to Steve and his wildlife conservation efforts. Operating seven days a week, the Croc Express is a fantastic way to get to Australia Zoo from your hotel in Surfers Paradise. This friendly service allows you to relax in air-conditioned comfort while learning about all the sights along the way. The tour departs at approximately 8.00am and arrives at Australia Zoo around 10.15am for all the wildlife action. The day is then yours to spend exploring the Zoo at your leisure, before departing at 4.30pm.

Penguin Parade - Phillip Island Full Afternoon & Evening Tour

Phillip Island is just under a two hour drive from Melbourne and is home to an astounding array of wildlife, including Australia's largest fur seal colony, the Little Penguins and cuddly koalas.

Each night at sunset, the world's smallest penguins, the Little Penguins, emerge from the sea and waddle ashore to their sand dune burrows. Experience the wonder of Little Penguins coming ashore after a day's fishing at sea. The elevated boardwalks and viewing stands allow you to enjoy all the 'penguin action' without disturbing them or their burrow homes. This is a truly memorable natural wildlife experience.

Yarra Valley Winery Tour - Full Day

Collected from your hotel, relax and enjoy the great scenery, famous wines and delicious cuisine of Victoria's premier wine region. Enjoy the lush ferns and dense forests of the nearby Dandenong Ranges. En route visit the Beautiful Sherbrooke Forest, home to lyrebirds, crimson rosellas, cockatoos and kookaburras, the native birds of Australia. Enjoy the picturesque mountain villages scattered along the way and the spectacular views of Melbourne's skyline. Ride the restored Puffing Billy Steam Train for a memorable journey on Australia's most notable narrow gauge railway; tour the Yarra Valleys beautiful verdant hills and prosperous vineyards. Enjoy a delicious lunch with local wines. After lunch, wander among Australia's unique birds and animals in the natural bushland setting of Healesville Wildlife Sanctuary, Australia's premier wildlife and nature sanctuary and home to over 200 species of Australian birds, mammals and reptiles. Get up close to koalas, kangaroos, wombats, emus, cockatoos, parrots and many more and witness the amazing and exciting Eagles Fly demonstration within the sanctuary. See Healesville Sanctuary's renowned nocturnal house with the shy platypus, walk through large aviaries and pond areas.




Great Ocean Road Tour - Full Day

We have had a close look at this tour and instead of the original idea of a two night trip we have changed this to a day trip. The power and majesty of nature reign supreme in this awe inspiring coastal landscape. View the popular coastal townships of Torquay and Lorne - a surfer's haven and retreat. Pass world famous Bells Beach, home to World Surfing Championships. See many fern filled gullies and river inlets on your journey. Travel the length of the Great Ocean Road passing towering limestone cliffs, sweeping white beaches and stunning forest scenery. Truly one of the world's great scenic coastal drives. Witness a fabulous spectacle of massive natural erosion. Contrasts abound between rugged coast and verdant rainforest living side by side. See the amazing Twelve Apostles (see photo) - limestone stacks rising dramatically from the Southern Ocean and visit the Information Centre. Walk along the boardwalk and enjoy the scenery from various viewing platforms. See Loch Ard Gorge and be swept away by the romantic and tragic story of love and lives lost aboard the Loch Ard. Explore Port Campbell National Park. Discover the tragic history of over 50 ships wrecked along this rugged coastline. Continue beyond Port Campbell to the remnants of London Bridge. Great photo locations include Razorback and Island Arch. See the spectacular night lights of Melbourne as you cross the West Gate Bridge.
